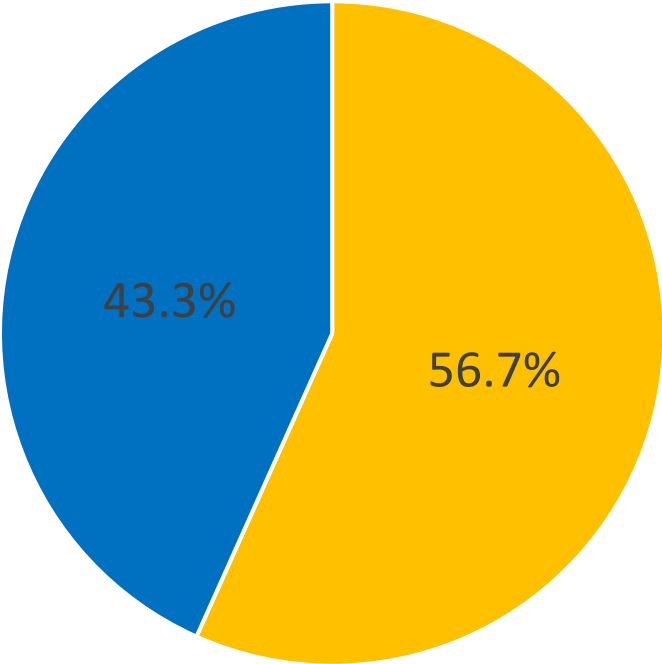

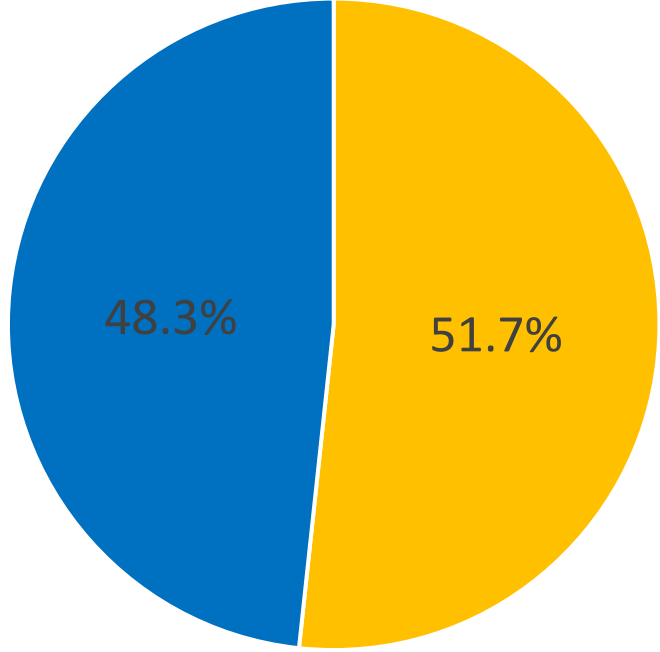

FAFSA by July 2021

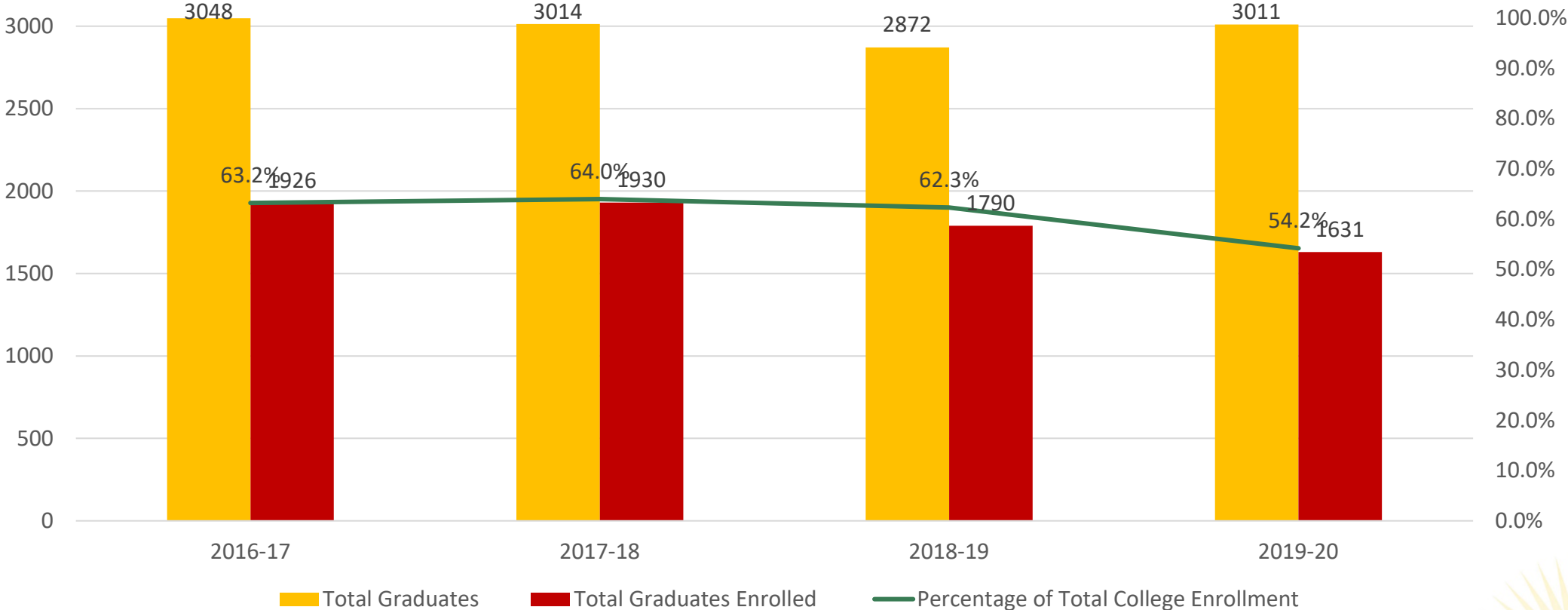

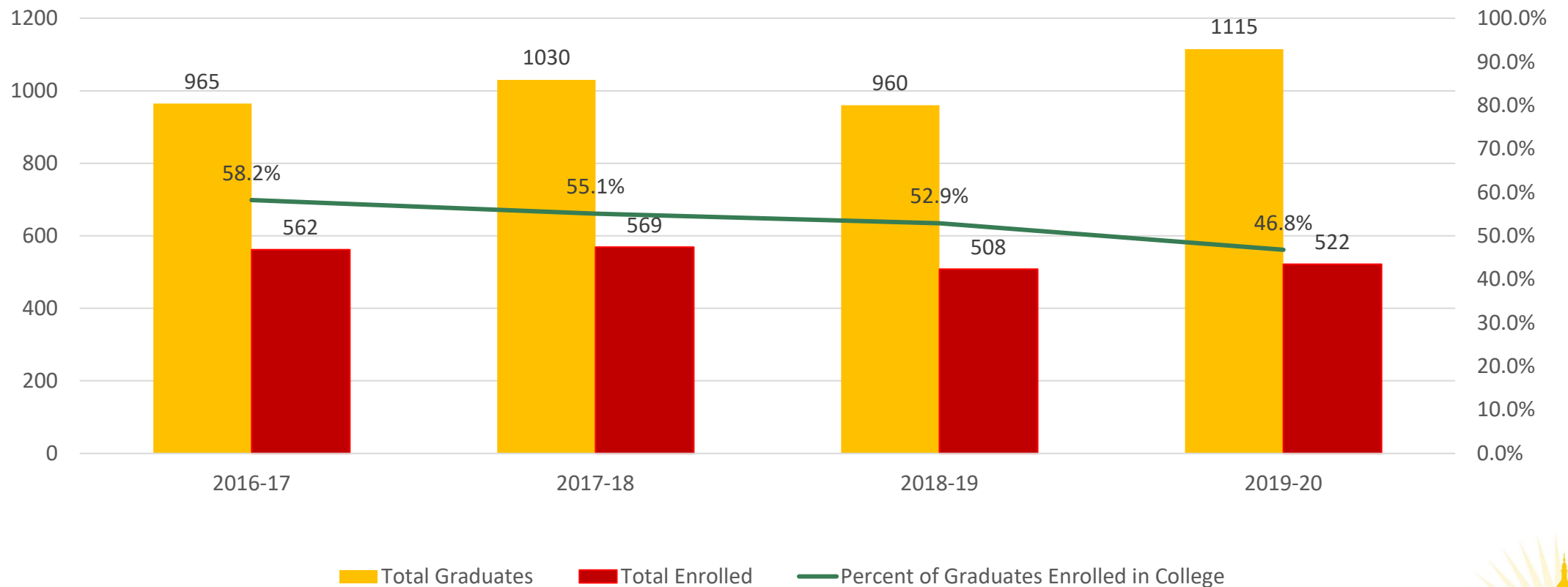
Ingham County Graduates and College Enrollment within 6 Months of Graduation

Eaton RESA Graduates and College Enrollment within 6 Months of Graduation

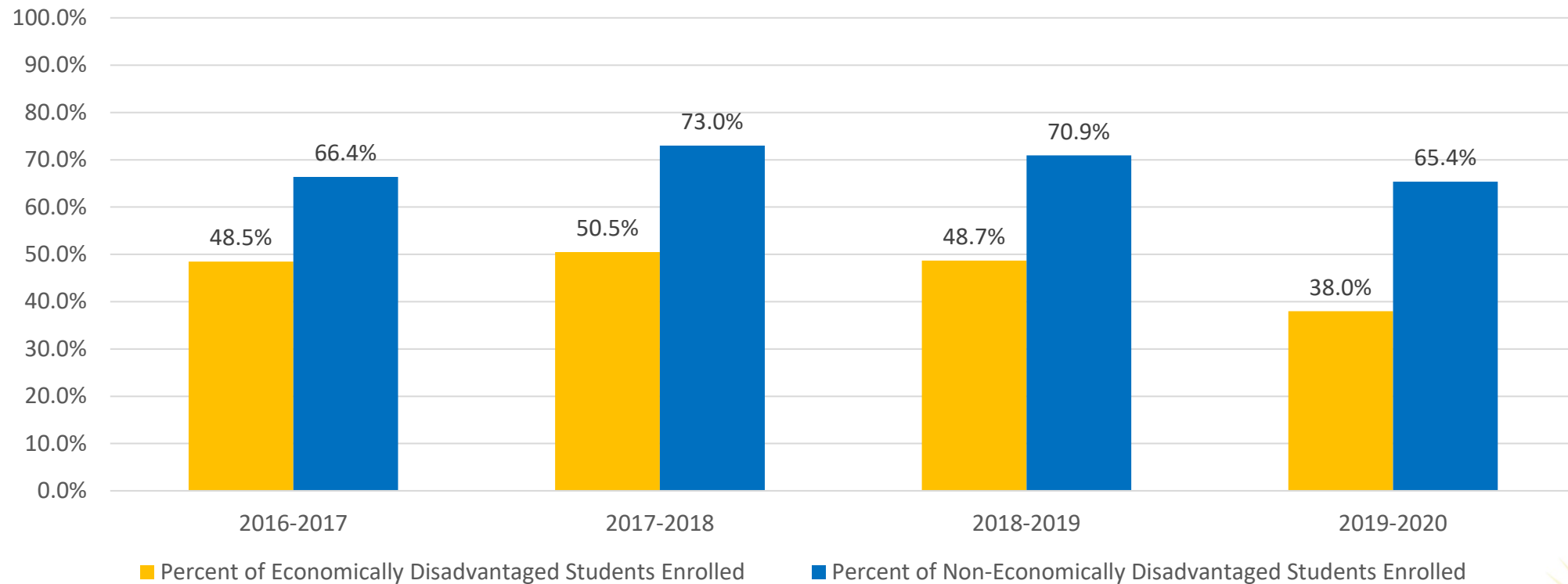

COLLEGE ENROLLMENT WITHIN 6 MONTHS OF GRADUATION



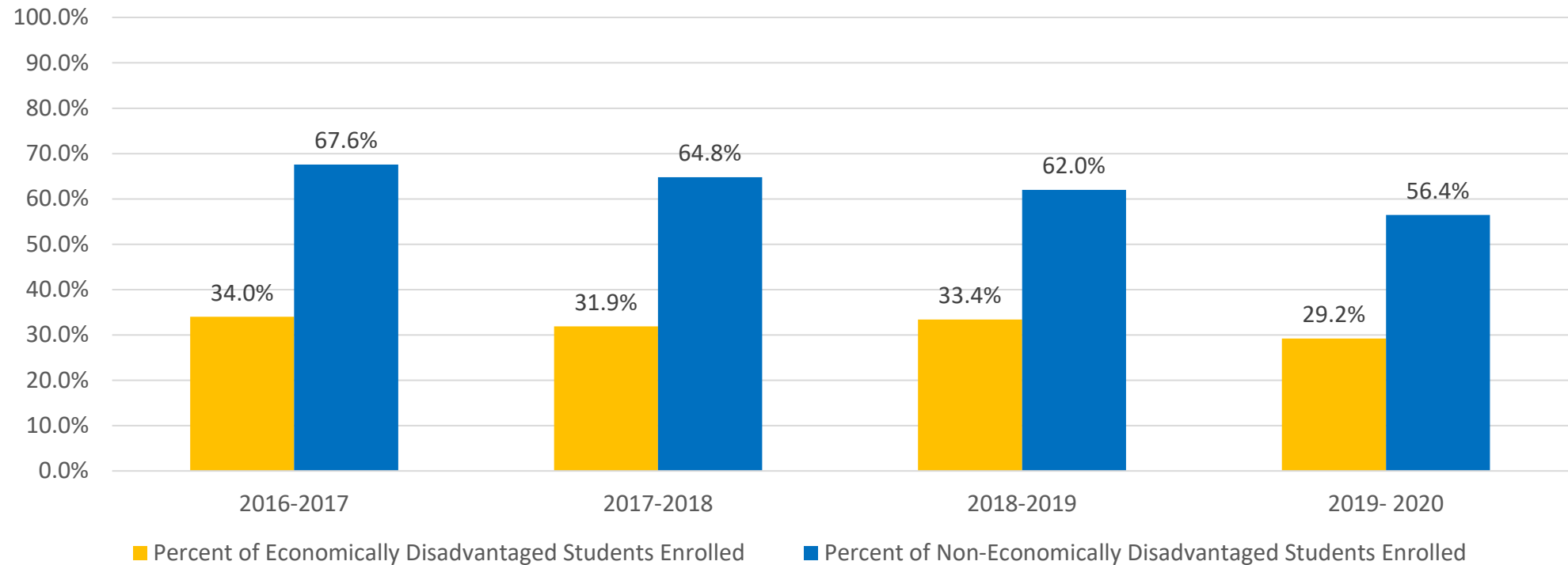

Economically Disadvantaged: Students who have been determined to be eligible for free or reduced-price meals via locally gathered and approved family applications under the National School Lunch program, are in households receiving food (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) or cash (Temporary Assistance to Needy Families) assistance, are homeless, are migrant, are in foster care, or, beginning in 2017-18, certain MEDICAID eligible children. When any of these conditions are present, a student is considered economically disadvantaged.



Economically Disadvantaged Graduates from Eaton RESA High Schools

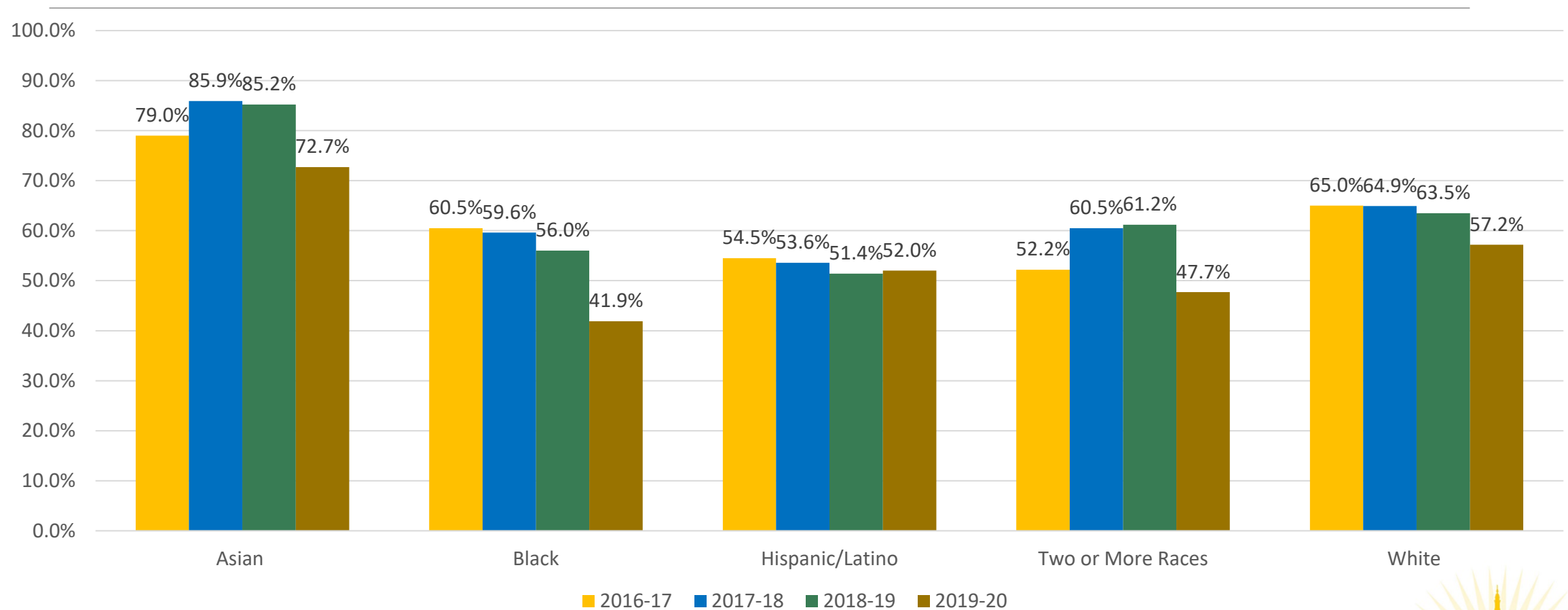
COLLEGE ENROLLMENT WITHIN 6 MONTHS OF GRADUATION

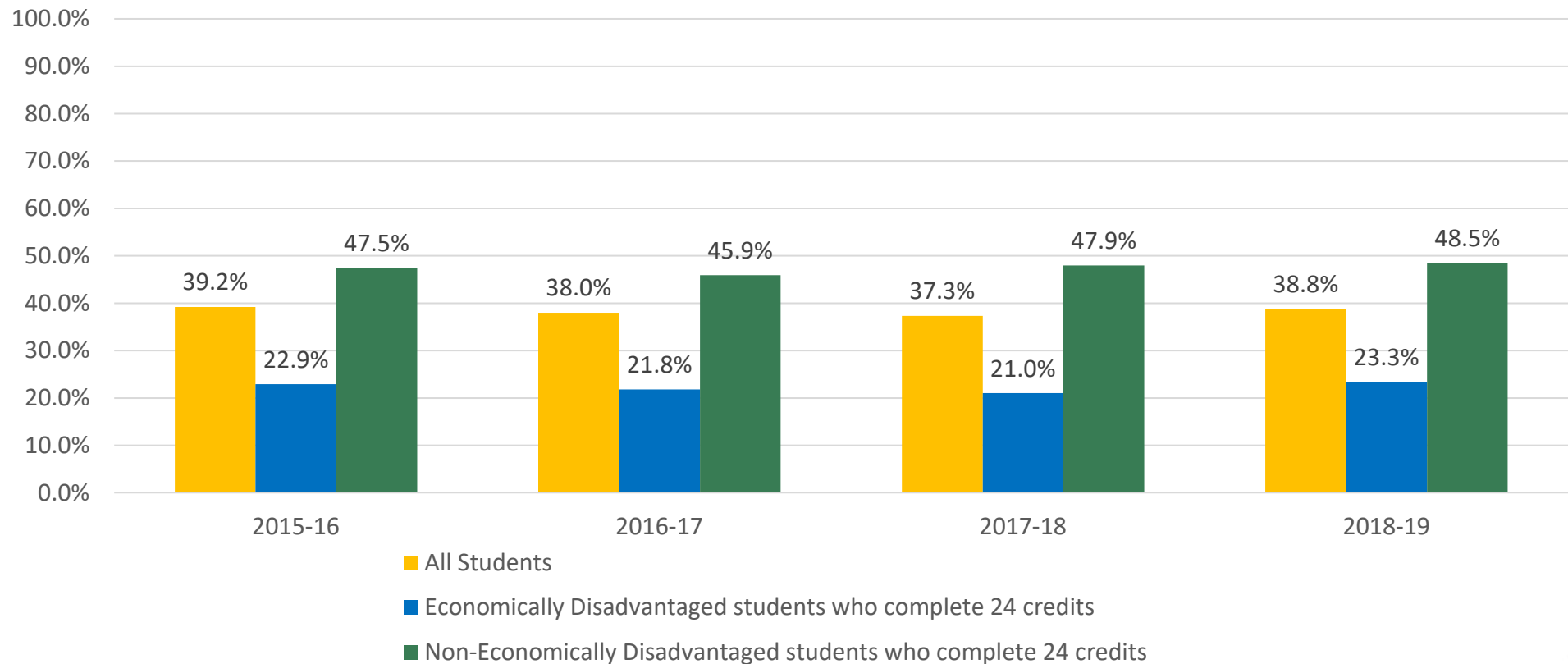
Ingham County College Enrollment within 6 months based on Race/Ethnicity

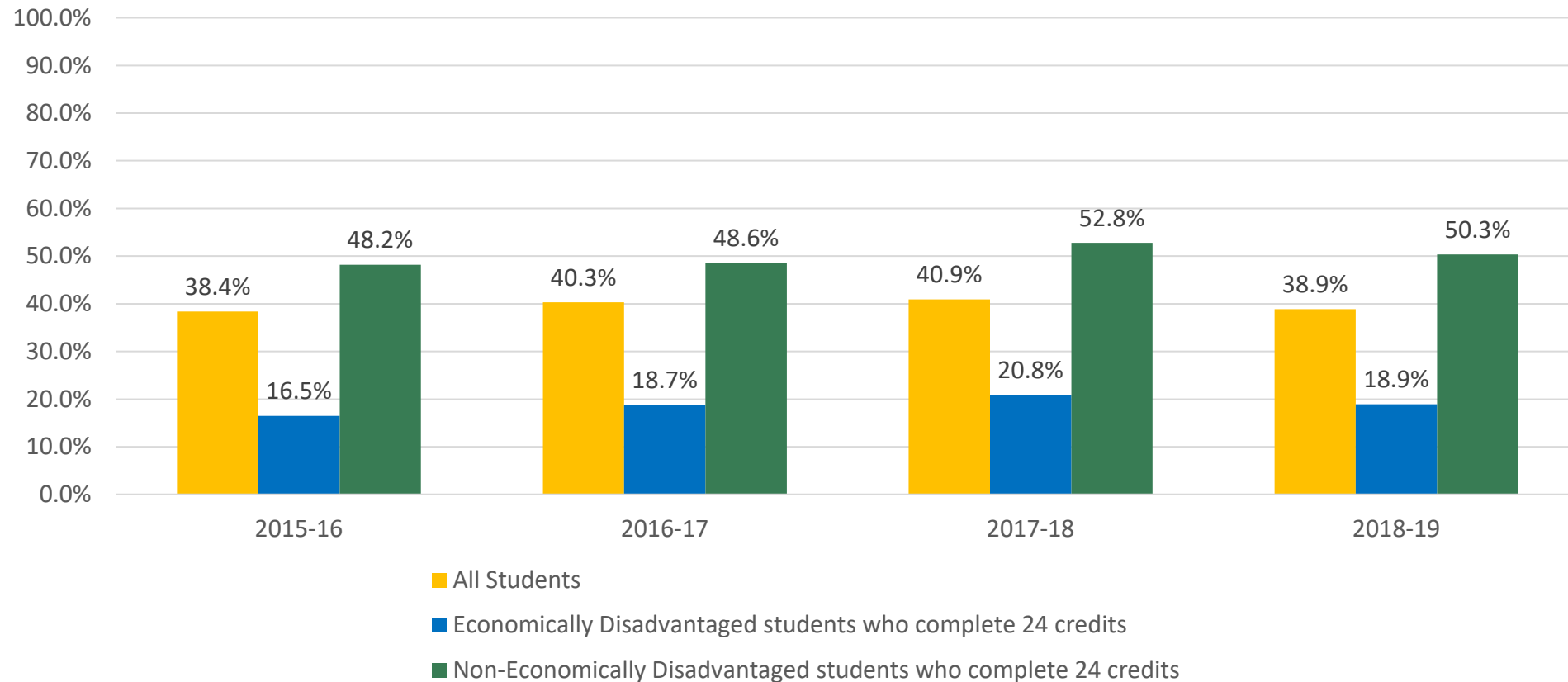
Ingham County Graduates Completing 24 Credits Following High School based on Socioeconomic Status within 12 months

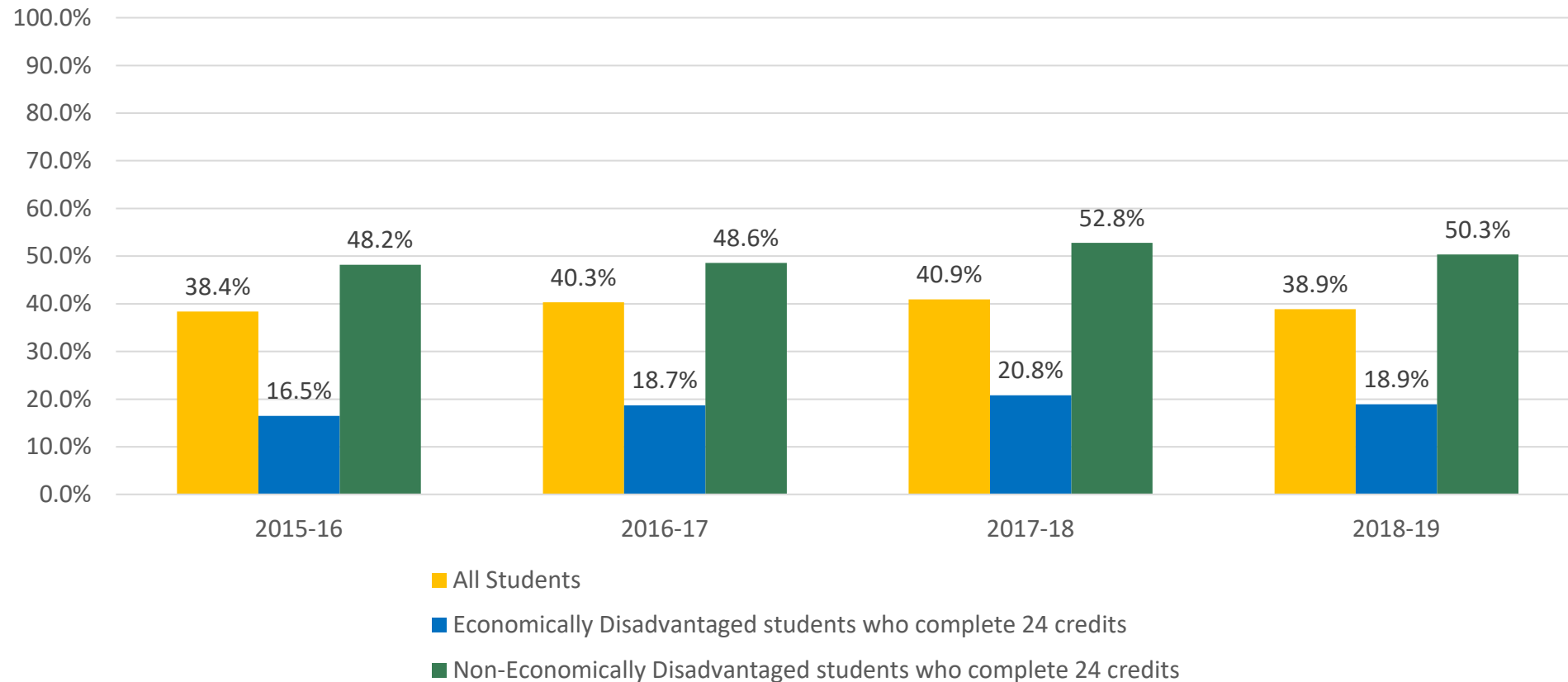
Eaton RESA Graduates Completing 24 Credits Following High School based on Socioeconomic Status within 12 months

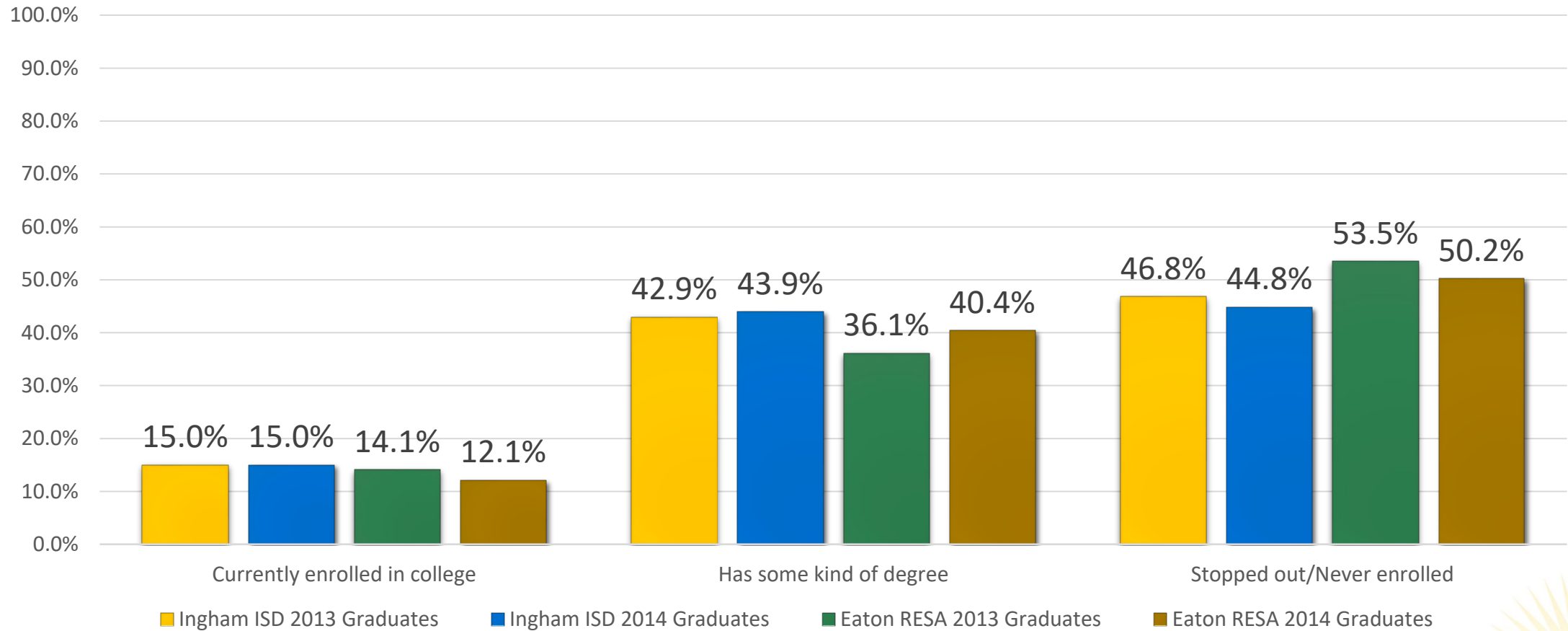

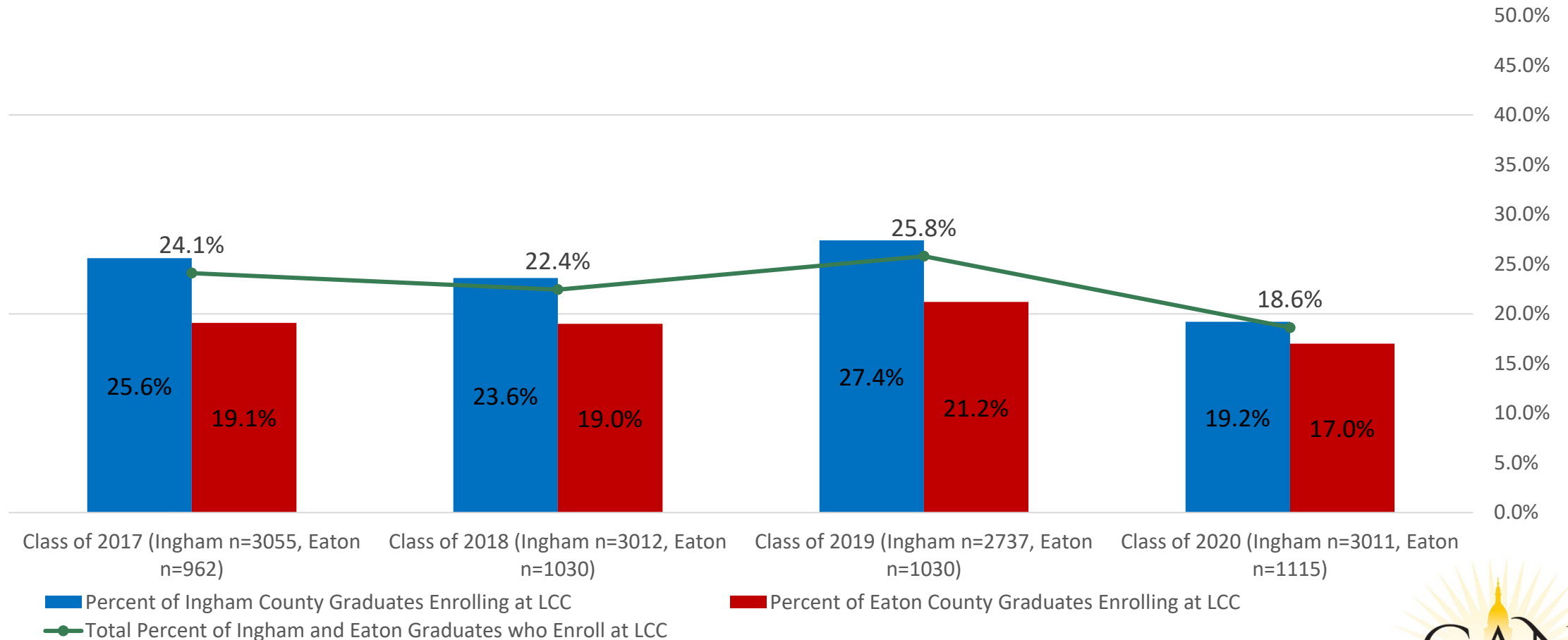
Class of 2013 and 2014 after 6 years

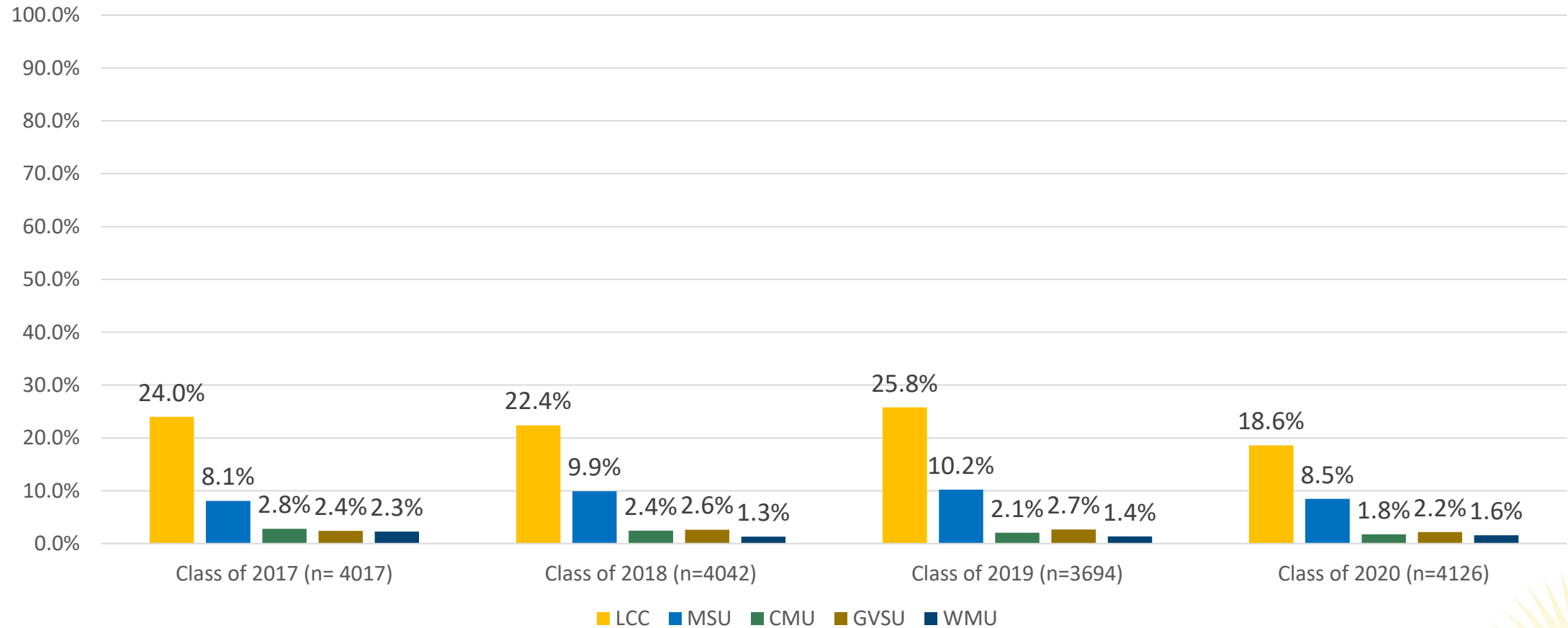
Aggregate Ingham and Eaton County Graduates Enrollment within 6 months at LCC

Top 5 schools where Ingham and Eaton Graduates enroll within 6 months of graduation

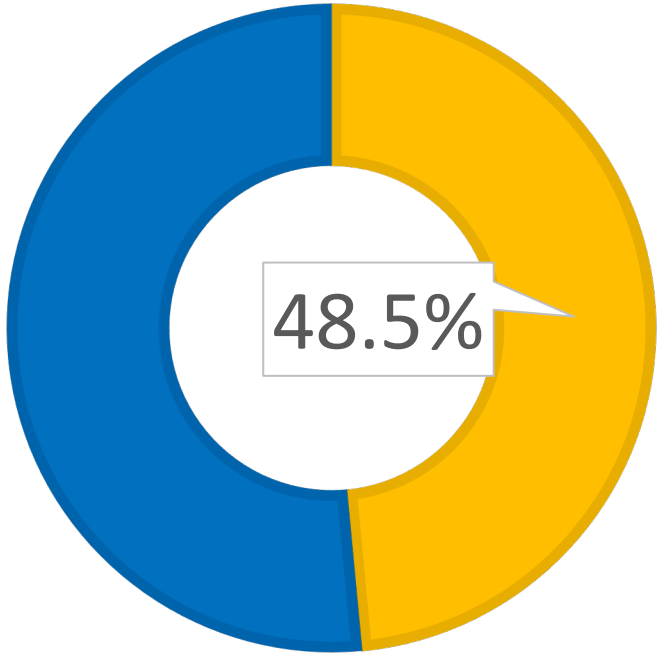

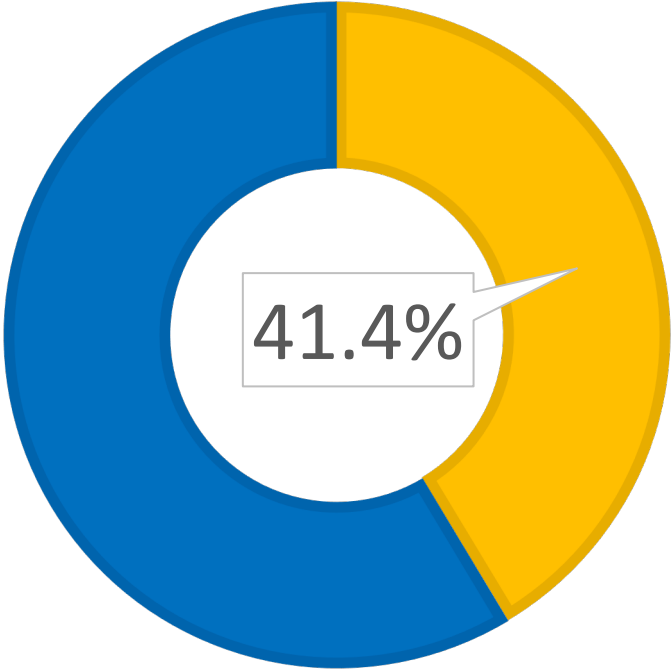


Degree Attainment (certificate +)
