These materials are available in:

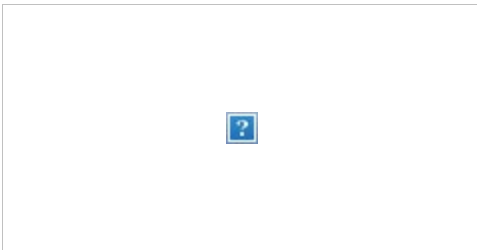
- Spanish,
