Cultural Briefings on arriving populations

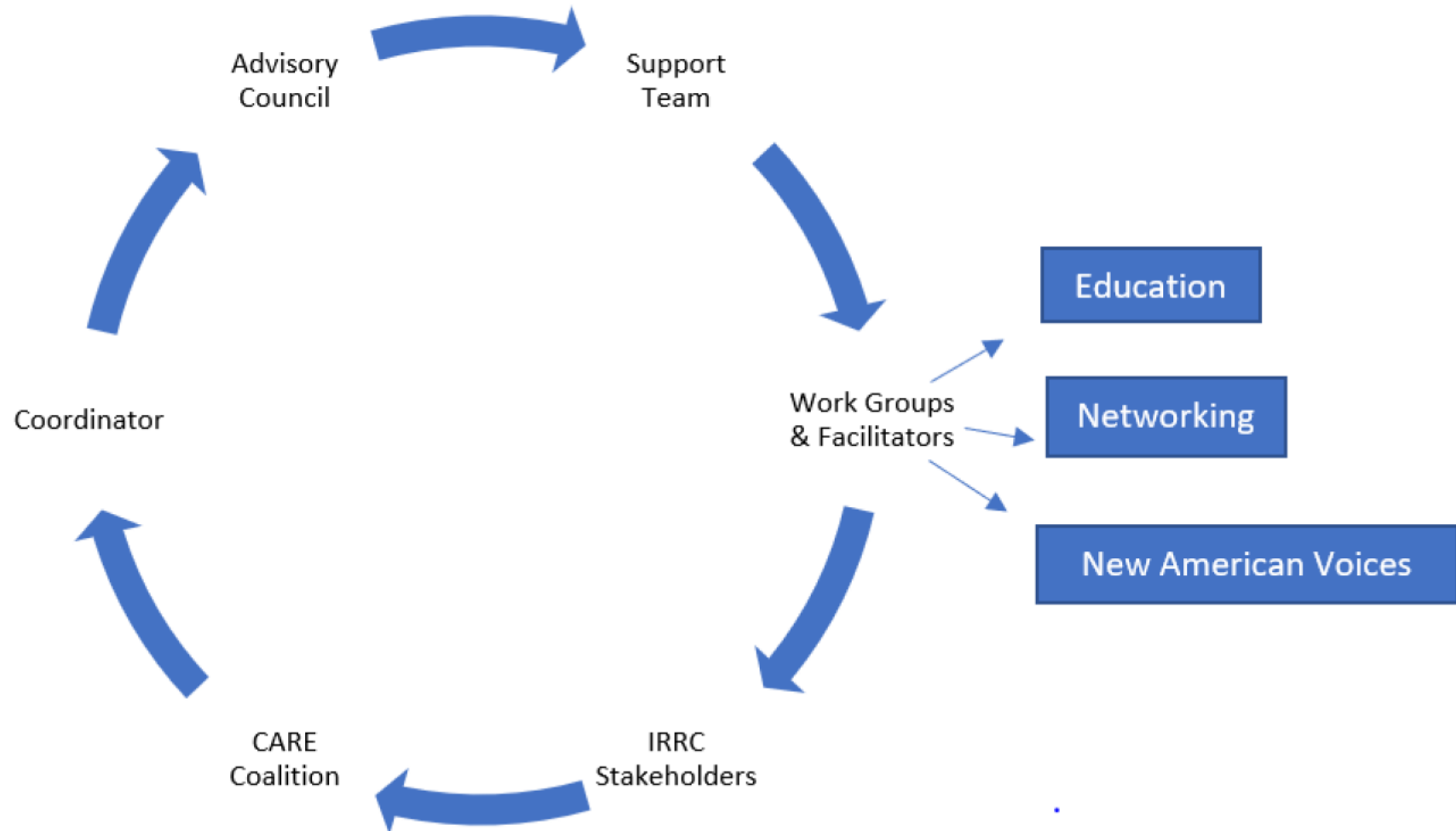
Work with local and state stakeholders to identify emerging needs/issues and help galvanize community around solutions
