Likely results from **Approval Voting**:

In an URBAN district, voters may favor reproductive health, racial equity, environmentalism, AND ending mass incarceration.

In a RURAL District voters may favor 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment rights, the Rule of Law, pro-life, AND government overreach.

In BOTH cases, some voters will vote strategically and only vote for one of the two dominant parties.

In EITHER case, **Approval Voting** delivers **stronger voter engagement** and **greater voter satisfaction** with the results.

Likely results from **not changing**:

In an URBAN district, most voters may select only the Democratic Party and maybe split their vote to the Labor Party, Rainbow or Taxpayers Party.

In a RURAL district, most voters may select the Republican Party and then the Natural Law or Taxpayers party or America First Party.
